Farnley Bank Footpath

Kirklees are preparing the draft report for Farnley Bank Footpath with the expectation that it will be presented to the planning sub-committee at the end of March 2022. Kirklees expect the application to be determined by the Council in the first half of 2022 with further stages after that before the decision to make an Order to record the footpath as a PROW is recorded.

**4. Financial Statement**

Balance as at 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2022 is £2,841.47

This includes £1008 for flutter payments on line and in cash. Total members 96.

**Thankyou to JW and FH for all their time and effort in managing the flutter and a huge thank you to everyone who is supporting the FTCTG by joining Farnley Flutter.**

The current bank balance holds £440 as operating costs from the £1000 grants received from Kirkburton Parish Council. These grants were issued by KPC to insure that Community Groups could continue to operate without being able to fund raise during the pandemic.

£600 for future Flutter winners

£850 towards future funds until the FTCTG can start fund raising again.

These all total £1890 which will leave approximately £950 to be used for the benefit of the Community.

Kirkburton Parish has confirmed that the annual grant of £300 for the FTCTG has been approved

An Oak Tree is to be collected from Thorp Perrow Arboretum and planted up at the recreation ground in the next week, Many thanks to RW and ML for arranging this. A Granite plinth has been commissioned which will be placed next to it and unveiled on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June. Both these are being funded by the generosity of a resident of Farnley Tyas.

A suggested event for the Platinum Jubilee is 'The Big Jubilee Picnic in the Park' to be held at the recreation ground on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June 12-6pm.

A committee has been formed to explore this suggestion and RW submitted details of the proposals so far.

These include the hire of toilets, Marquee/Beer Tent/Ice Cream Van/Tea and Cake Stall/Face Painting/Craft stalls/Brass band/Bouncy Castles.

### NB regarding the Bouncy Castles;

\*If the wind reaches 18mph, the supplier will automatically collect the castles

\*For children's use only, not to be used by adults

\*The castles to be monitored by stewards whilst in use

\*The 'Risk Assessment' form issued by Kirklees Council to be completed which strengthens the terms of their insurance (and ours). FTCTG insurance covers 3<sup>rd</sup> party claims

\*A resident has volunteered to be on duty for medical assistance
