*Ivy Farm planning application; The meeting passed a motion requesting that the FTCTG comment on this application focusing on the proposed access track and the harm caused to the Green Belt.

*The FTCTG committee drafted a response on behalf the FTCTG which was submitted to Kirklees planning.

*Kirklees Council have acknowledged receipt of KH's report on the condition of footpath signs

4. Financial Statement

Balance as at 2nd March 2022 is £2,910.58

The above balance includes £1,152 flutter payments made on line and £144 flutter payments made in cash.

Payments out since February; £50 flutter winner for February and £5 HSBC monthly bank charge.

The current balance now includes at the moment - held as follows

£410 as operating/running costs during the pandemic from the £1000 grants received from KPC (Kirkburton Parish Council)

£550 for future flutter winners

£900 towards future funding until the FTCTG can start fund raising again

TOTAL to hold is approximately £1,860

This leaves around £1,050 that could be used for the benefit of the community.

KPC have approved the annual grant of £300 which should be paid to the FTCTG April/May.

The FTCG have applied for a grant of up to £1,000 from One Community to pay towards the proposed Queens Platinum Jubilee event in the village

Kirklees Council are still working on their annual budget.

*Kirkburton Parish Council

The Parish Council is running another Fruit Tree Pruning Workshop for apple and pear trees.

The course is due to be held in March.

6.Queen's Platinum Jubilee

An oak tree plus a sandstone plinth has been donated to the community by a resident of Farnley Tyas.

The oak tree has been purchased from Thorp Perrow Arboretum and planted alongside the tree for the Queen's Diamond Jubilee at the recreation ground. The sandstone plinth will be unveiled as part of the proposed event to be held on

Sunday 5th June. The wording was agreed at the meeting and is to be;

"This oak presented by a village resident 2022 commemorates the Platinum Jubilee of HM Queen Elizabeth II"

Kirklees Council have confirmed in principal that no rent will be charged for the hire of the recreation ground
