Thanks to KH for all her help in applying for a grant of £270 from Kirkburton Parish Council to help cover the cost of replacing the Defibrillator Cabinet, the present one is leaking and needs replacing asap.

The approximate cost of the new cabinet is £550.00. The FTCCG agreed at a full meeting in June to cover the additional costs involved.

The cost of running the FTCCG website has been increased to £68 per annum.

5. Council updates

Kirklees Council

KC parks department will be cutting back on the amount of grass cutting in their parks and this will also apply to grass verges around the Kirklees area. This is due to staff shortages and Council cut backs. If you identify a problem with road sight lines being affected by overgrown verges, please contact Cllr Armer who will forward your concerns on to the appropriate department at KC.

The unauthorised access track to Ivy Farm is still awaiting a decision from the Planning Inspectorate. Cllr Armer contacted KC enforcement in June and then again in July in response due to concerns raised from residents about the track being used for the Honley Show. Following concerns raised at the meeting Cllr Armer will contact KC enforcement again.

There is still a huge backlog in KC PROW department so a decision has not yet been reached about Farnley Bank. This is also causing a delayed decision on the surface to Field Lane. FH to email Cllr Armer with full details on concerns raised by residents.

The meeting was informed about problems with tarmac being raised in places and potholes along Manor Road. Cllr Armer agreed to contact KC with the concerns raised.

Kirkburton Parish Council

Thanks were offered to KPC for agreeing to sign the Access Licence for the Village Square. This was a unanimous decision at a full council meeting.

Cllr Barraclough has arranged for the noticeboard to be repaired.

An email was sent to the clerk at KPC/Cllrs Barraclough and Cooper on 1st June 2023 thanking them for all their help.
